

IPC- Migration



Dear Parents,

Here is an outline of what we will be learning for this half term in Milepost 3.

IPC

Our unit this half-term is 'Moving People'. We will be learning about migration through the following subjects:

In Geography we will learn about why we and other people have moved to different places, and we will learn about similarities and differences between places we know. We will learn how natural disasters affect migration and how disaster relief organisations work.

In History we will learn about the migration of people throughout history, including the spread of ideas, technology and culture. We will learn why these movements occurred and how it affects us today.

In Society we will learn about refugees and the organisations that help them.

In International we will learn about economic migration and how migrants and refugees are treated in our home and host countries.

If your child has some work to research, please help them, but without actually doing the work. If you have the chance to further their interest in the ideas of this theme please take it, but your enthusiasm and interest is most important.

By the end of the unit, we hope your child has achieved all of the learning targets. We hope they have had an enjoyable time in the classroom. And we hope you have enjoyed seeing your child work with enthusiasm. If you have any comments about the work your child has done, please get in touch.

Entry Point—Wednesday 4th Nov

Please inform your child that, for their entry point, they will be imagining they are people who are moving away from Gamba. They should be given only five minutes, before they come to school (or the evening before, if easier!) to fill a small bag (rucksack size) with the things they would take.

During the school day we will have a look at what they have chosen to bring with them and will build an outdoors day camp, where we will prepare a basic meal for lunch. Please ensure that your child has their hat, water, mosquito repellent and sun cream.
